RESOLUTION NO. 2025-187

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE DRONE REPLACEMENT PROGRAM GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$100,000); AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, OR DESIGNEE, TO EXECUTE THE ATTACHED GRANT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF LAW ENFORCEMENT (FDLE) AND THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK FOR USE OF THE GRANT FUNDS TO PURCHASE FOUR (4) DRONES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Coconut Creek applied for the Drone Replacement Program and was one of the organizations selected by FDLE to receive one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) in grant funding; and

WHEREAS, the grant will allow the Coconut Creek Police Department to purchase four (4) drones that will enhance public safety and operational efficiency; and

WHEREAS, the City Commission finds and determines that it is in the best interest of the City to accept the grant funding.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

- <u>Section 1:</u> That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution. All exhibits attached hereto are incorporated herein and made a specific part of this resolution.
- **Section 2:** That the City Commission hereby accepts the Drone Replacement Program Grant in the amount of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000).
- <u>Section 3:</u> That the City Commission has reviewed and hereby approves the attached agreement between the Florida Department of Law Enforcement and the City of Coconut Creek for the purpose of purchasing four (4) drones.
- <u>Section 4:</u> That the Mayor, or designee, is hereby authorized to execute said agreement, attached hereto and made part hereof, between the Florida Department of

Law Enforcement and the City of Coconut Creek for the purpose of purchasing four (4) drones.

<u>Section 5:</u> That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 6: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
