WHEREAS, when an emergency occurs, the prompt response of police officers, firefighters, and paramedics is critical to the protection of life and preservation of property; and

WHEREAS, the safety of our first responders is dependent upon the quality and accuracy of information obtained from citizens who call the Coconut Creek Police Department's Real Time Crime Center and the Coral Springs/Parkland/Coconut Creek Emergency Communications Center; and

WHEREAS, the Coconut Creek Police Department's Real Time Crime Center and the Coral Springs/Parkland/Coconut Creek Emergency Communications Center Telecommunicators are the first and most critical contact our citizens have with emergency services; and

WHEREAS, the Coconut Creek Police Department's Real Time Crime Center and Coral Springs/Parkland/Coconut Creek Telecommunicators are the single vital link for our police officers and firefighters by monitoring their activities by radio, providing them information, and ensuring their safety; and

WHEREAS, each of the Coconut Creek Police Department's Real Time Crime Center and Coral Springs/Parkland/Coconut Creek Telecommunicators have exhibited compassion, understanding, and professionalism during the performance of their job in the past year.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Commission of the City of Coconut Creek, Florida, hereby proclaims April 9-15, 2023, as

"NATIONAL TELECOMMUNICATIONS WEEK"

in the City of Coconut Creek in honor of the public safety telecommunicators whose diligence and professionalism keep our City and citizens safe.
