

RESOLUTION NO. 2024-043

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA, IN SUPPORT OF THE CITY'S REQUEST FOR COMMUNITY PROJECT FUNDING FOR FLEET BUILDING REHABILITATION AND A REDUNDANT FIBER OPTIC RING, WHICH SUPPORTS THE CITY'S VISION 2030 STRATEGIC PLAN AND STRATEGIC GOALS ADDRESSING SAFETY AND QUALITY OF LIFE, SUSTAINABLE ENVIRONMENT, AND HIGH PERFORMANCE GOVERNMENT; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, as part of the City's Vision 2030 10-year strategic plan, the City of Coconut Creek is committed to fiscal accountability and high performance government, including seeking all possible federal, state, and local grant opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the City intends to request support and advocacy from Congressman Jared Moskowitz for Community Project Funding for two (2) projects in 2024: Fleet Building Rehabilitation and construction and installation of a Redundant Fiber Optic Ring; and

WHEREAS, a resolution of support from the City of Coconut Creek's City Commission is encouraged as part of the Community Project Funding application; and

WHEREAS, these two (2) projects have been identified as strategic priorities that will help the City ensure safety and quality of life, a sustainable environment, high performance government, and contribute to the City's mission to provide exceptional, responsive, and sustainable services for the Coconut Creek community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COMMISSION OF THE CITY OF COCONUT CREEK, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the foregoing "WHEREAS" clauses are hereby ratified and confirmed as being true and correct and are hereby made a specific part of this resolution.

Section 2: That the City Commission hereby supports the Community Project Funding request for Fleet Building Rehabilitation and a Redundant Fiber Optic Ring.

Section 3: That if any clause, section, other part or application of this resolution is held by any court of competent jurisdiction to be unconstitutional or invalid, in part or in application, it shall not affect the validity of the remaining portion or applications of this resolution.

Section 4: That this resolution shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its adoption.
